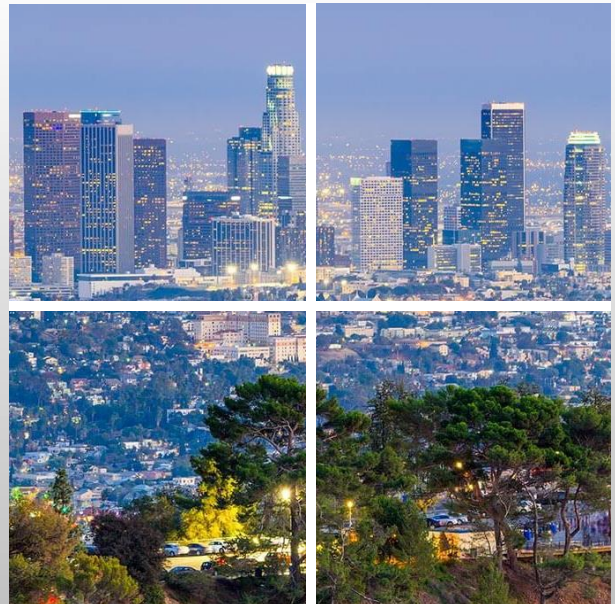

Services

Shop Drawings

We carry out the Shop Drawing service according to the design and plans provided by the client. We usually include the Shop Drawing service in our quotes. But the client determines whether or not they require the Shop Drawing service in the budget.

The shop drawings provide the exact instructions to fabricate and erect, also the plans and the Bill of Material

Steel fabrication

The Steel fabrication is typically done in the shop. This process typically consists of the following steps:

1. Cut the proper lengths
2. Create templates and or mark steel
3. Punch or drill holes
4. Camber members (If required)
5. Prepare accessory steel pieces
6. Add shop welded or bolted pieces to members
7. Clean members (Can be done before cutting)
8. Tag steel members
9. Surface treatments (Painting and or galvanizing)

Steel erection

Erection or installation service on-site, for residential, commercial and industrial buildings. We also offer retrofit and restoration services of steel structures.

Ornamental Metal Works
